2019 Comeragh CC League - Rule Updates 1. Marshaling Points In an effort to meet the additional marshaling requirements imposed by Gardai all Comeragh Riders are expected to marshal 2 league races per season. In order to eliminate the points disadvantage associated with this requirement the following applies to this and future editions of the league: 1. All Comeragh riders are expected to marshal 2 league races per season 2. Comeragh rider may arrange alternative cover for 1 of these nights if arranged BY THE RIDER in advance with marshal coordinator 3. For each league race that a Comeragh rider marshals (Up max 2 races) they will be awarded the average points they achieved in the league races they did actually ride, measured over the entire league. EXAMPLE a. Comeragh Rider rides 4 races over entire league and scores 20 points. Average (20 points div 4 races) = 5 points b. Same Comeragh Rider Marshals 1 race. Therefore total points = 20 from races + 5 for marshalling night = 25 points total c. Points awarded over 5 races in this instance d. Same scenario but say rider marshals 2 nights then its 20 + 5 + 5= 30 points total 4. Marshall points will be allocated after final league race based on average race points over entire league (As noted up max 2 Marshall nights) 5. Points to be rounded to the nearest whole number for each marshalling night >/= 0.5 = rounded up nearest whole number, < 0.5 rounded down to nearest whole number. In event tie the unrounded number shall apply 2. Race Numbers Cycling Ireland race numbers by all participating riders on each night of the league race. No Numbers = No Race Riders that don't have CI race numbers, ie. Limited competition License, Race Numbers will be provided at sign on. 3. Marshal Race Briefing All marshals to be at Carroll's Cross at 7.00pm for pre-race safety briefing. Hazard Red Flag, Hi-Viz vests and race signs will be allocated to marshals. Review of marshal duties and locations will be completed by marshal co-ordinator. Marshal Co-ordinator contact details to be issued to all marshals at pre-race briefing. If you plan on cycling out to the league race on your rostered night, you must bring suitable attire with you. No Marshalling in cycling gear, as per instruction of Gardai. 4. Marshal Roster Notification Notification text will be sent out Thursday evening for following Tuesday's roster. Please confirm availability by Sunday evening.
